	<p>Decision Cllr Philip Whalley requesting that the £1,500 digital literacy money carried over from 2016/17 be put towards the Wiltshire Heritage Walks Project - Approved</p> <p>Youth Funding Decision Pound Arts awarded £3,170 for the Take Over Project</p> <p>Decision Make believe Arts awarded £1,704 for the Make believe Arts Project</p> <p>Health and Wellbeing Funding Decision Carer Support Wiltshire awarded £2,970 towards reaching lonely and isolated carers and residents</p> <p>Decision Bradford Music Centre awarded £1,500 towards the Celebrating Age project for 2018/19</p> <p>Decision The remaining H&WB funding and the remaining Capital Grants funding to go towards match funding for a digital app to help the surgery and all H&WB partners link support to patients - Approved</p> <p>Delegated Decisions Great British Spring Clean – Expenditure was made under delegated authority of £342.38 for litter picking equipment.
