Performance – Bradford on Avon Stats

- The largest proportion of victims were males aged 40-50 (14.6%) followed by females aged 30-40 (11.2%). The largest proportion of suspects were males aged 30-40 (18.5%)

- 3 Community Resolutions have been issued
- 1 Adult caution has been issued
- 1 Youth restorative disposal issued
- 1 educational input provided as a disposal
- 15.3% of crimes detected
- 56.3% of crimes are still in the process of being investigated

Trowbridge / Melksham / Bradford On Avon – Community Policing Team Results 2023

- 1) Suspect of Multiple Offences of Burglary – Sentenced to 54 Imprisonment for Burglary.
- 2) Serious Assault Investigation Melksham (Investigation completed by the Neighbourhood Team) – Suspect Sentenced to 42 Months for GBH.
- 3) Arrest of Suspect on Suspicion of Burglary, Theft from Motor Vehicle and Theft of Motor Vehicle. This relating to a Crime Series of offending, in excess of 40 reported crimes across, Trowbridge, Melksham and Devizes between Dec 22 and Feb 23 – Currently on Remand in Prison - **Offending has Ceased**
- 4) Arrest of Burglary Suspect – Suspect released from Prison in January 23. Forensically Linked to 1 of a series of 11 Day-Time Dwelling Burglaries in Trowbridge between Feb and March 23. Previous Imprisonment for Burglary and Theft offences. Currently on Strict Bail Conditions of Curfew and doorstep presentation. – **Offending has Ceased**
- 5) Three Closure Orders obtained from the Magistrates Court for 3 Addresses in Trowbridge and Melksham. Both addresses linked to Drug Supply and ASB.
- 6) Two Mis-use of Drugs Warrants executed in support of the County Lines Intensification week. Three other Warrants executed this year across the CPT in response to Community Intelligence, with two warrants to be executed in the coming weeks.
- 7) 115 Recorded Community Engagements this year by the Trowbridge/Melksham/Bradford on Avon Neighbourhood Policing Team (School Visits / Coffee Mornings / Parish Meetings/Public Events).
- 8) Operation Sceptre – The Knife amnesty saw the surrender of 72 Knives and bladed weapons over the 2 week Operation, which local officers supported with a visit to Trowbridge College with the Knife Arch detector.

What have we done this month

- We have carried out a total of 25 plus documented patrols of the Market Place to curb anti social cycling- no reports since.
- We have arrested a prolific burglar who has been found guilty at court for breaking in to Gompels - case adjourned for sentencing.
- We have attended Pub Watch and assisted with the banning of two offenders.
- We have assisted in a multi agency approach dealing with a long running neighbour dispute which is in the process of resolution.
- We have carried out a full weekend of Community Engagement for the King's Coronation in Melksham and surrounding villages.
