A launch event for the festival was held at one of the pubs in Colerne on 6 July and was promoted to the whole community to encourage participation in the planning and development of the festival so that it reflects the environmental and social interests of the whole community. 30 people attended the launch event and a team of 16 residents is actively engaged in planning the festival and the environmentally friendly bag campaign. The festival is part of an ongoing programme of events and activities to inspire, stimulate and engage the Colerne community in building a sustainable village.

The campaign to provide each household in Colerne with a robust environmentally friendly shopping bag will involve participation from the three shops in Colerne. The shops will provide figures for the decrease in consumption of plastic bags by shoppers in the village, by reporting the reduction in the number of plastic bags that the shops are required to purchase.
