To purchase musical instruments for local young people aged 7-18 (or 25 if they have special needs) to use during and after a 2 year programme. (These will form part of the instrument budget for the Youth Music application.)

What does your project aim to achieve? This project will give young people a new activity. The music workshops will encourage them to express themselves, share experiences and learn about teamwork. It will give them the skills and confidence to enjoy playing music together and continue to do so after the project ends and give them the confidence to join other groups. We aim to hold monthly workshops over a 2 year period. There will also be full day events and performances and a week long summer school each year in the summer holidays. Activities will include improvisation, song writing and composition. The project leader (Al Summers, who has worked with PAWS) is experienced at allowing people to set their own programme and to record the results on CD and video and DVD. We will identify local people to be trained as music leaders so ensuring that the enthusiasm is sustained after the end of the formal project.

If there are on-going running costs to your project please tell us how these will be met in future (not by NWDC) The 2 year project will we hope be funded by Youth Music. If further occasional workshops are needed after the end of the project Oaksey Youth Club will seek funding when necessary. We anticipate that the new trainee leaders will be able to give some help in a voluntary capacity.

How will this project benefit local people and approximately how many will benefit? We think approx 130 young people will be involved over the 2 years. New leaders will also be of great benefit to the community both during and after the 2 years. At the end of the project there will be a core of material which can be used by a number of groups such as Sunday school, Primary school and Youth Club. Parents and other local residents will have the opportunity to participate as trainee leaders, becoming voluntary helpers at workshop sessions, or helping with refreshments.

Oaksey Youth Club members have expressed enthusiasm for musical activities. So we have approached Youth Music (a Lottery fund) for a grant to fund this 2 year programme. As well as paying for music leaders, Youth Music ask that we train new music leaders (capacity building for the local community). They also ask that continuing professional development for the leaders themselves be organised. (CPD). We hope to start the programme in the Easter holidays 2006 and that it will run till Easter 2008. If the Youth Music Grant application is not successful we are still proposing to run a 1 day workshop and some follow up sessions for which the instruments purchased will be essential. Oaksey Youth Club will seek the necessary funding. Instruments will also be used at regular Youth Club sessions and village performances as members confidence increases.

We intend to purchase the following instruments - 2 x handroll pianos, steel pans, chime bars, drum kit, 4 x bongos, 4 x single drums, 4 x beaters and various percussion
