<b>What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Street entertainment in front of Sainsbury's on a busy Saturday morning will effectively take the Festival to the people of Calne – a potential audience of several thousand/</li> <li>A performance by the full Emerald Ensemble will provide the community with the rare possibility of hearing a professional orchestra. Needless to say, with the ensemble's fee of £1800 the event will have to be heavily subsidised. Potential audience 15-200.</li> <li>Two workshops at the John Bentley School by New Scorpion, a professional and highly entertaining folk group, will provide the teenage pupils at the school with a rare musical experience. It would also reinforce the links between the Festival and our local comprehensive school. The number participating will depend on the school – two classes or perhaps 200 pupils.</li> </ol>

- The educational workshops will appeal to and be targeted at teenagers, most of whom rarely take advantage of the Festival. The workshops will also enhance the experience of the scheduled evening performance.
- Total expected expenditure for the whole of the Festival this year is £14500.
