Substantial improvement to the visual aspect of this amenity. There is currently a small grass verge between the wall surrounding the pond and the road. The trustees haven maintained this verge on a regular basis. However there have been considerable problems with vehicles damaging the verge either from parking on it or from inconsiderable driving. This has made mowing the verge very difficult and of late, impossible. We have spoken with the Wiltshire highways Partnership who have agreed that the best solution is to install kerbing that must comply with the requirements laid down for a conservation area. The pond is home to a least 14 species of ducks and two black swans. It is visited by many visitors from the surrounding villages and from miles around. It features in a number of publications and is included in the itineraries of many hikers, cyclists and horse riders. A number of mini buses bring children, the aged and the disabled to feed the ducks.

3 - Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g. consultation & community involvement

Enclosed is copy of the Alderton newsletter, which included a copy of the audited accounts, details of the different species of ducks, the Trustees, some recent improvements and the source of visitors. The pond is tended twice daily plus regular mowing of grass and general maintenance. Voluntary labour and gifts are calculated as at least £1,525 based on labour: 20minutes daily (120 hours), grass cutting (30 hours), maintenance (40 hours). Total (190 hours) at say £7.50 per hour = 1,425. Foodstuffs grain £100, bread (out of date – value nil). This does not include the specific projects, which have been undertaken. The pond is supported by the Parish Council who have endorsed the current project.
