<p>We propose to take 51 people (plus two volunteer helpers) by coach to Bristol Hippodrome in January 2007 to see Peter Pan. The families who will benefit from this are unlikely to have experienced this kind of family based entertainment/culture before.</p> <p>It is believed that this can help to reinforce ideas of families enjoying spending time together, sharing happy and stimulating activities and creating happy memories.</p> <p>In the long term this kind of activity may influence people to place more value on their own families, and also their wider neighbourhoods and community.</p>

CFAG was set up to support families and children in deprived circumstances. We are supported by Barnados.

Our project aims to provide activities, trips and workshops for children in holiday times, which they'd otherwise not have the opportunity to participate in due to lack of resources within families. Families targeted are on low incomes, often on long term benefits and often experiencing difficulties within the families such as alcohol and drug abuse or relationship breakdowns or long term illness.

Although the trip is heavily subsidise all families will make a contribution towards their participation.
