Coleman's Farm Learning & Community Centre Association has had three recent (during 2005) well-attended public meetings with Westlea Housing Association where local residents and tenants and the Community Centre Association identified the brook as unsafe and an eyesore (See Newsletter attached).

The Baseline Ecological Survey is the first part of an ecological and environmental project to clean-up the Abberd brook and pond at the Coleman's Farm estate, Calne. The ultimate aim is for the brook and pond to be visually more appealing and accessible to the residents of the estate and the people of Calne, and for everyone living in the area to be able to enjoy and appreciate the diverse fauna and flora that exist there.

To achieve this aim, the project will need to employ a design and landscape consultancy to liaise with all interested parties (local residents and environmental groups) to come up with plans acceptable by them, Calne Town Council, NWDC and other the statutory authorities.
