

## Dates and Changes in Activities: Claimed Route and Neighbouring Properties

- 1843 Inland Revenue Tithe Map and Award. Claimed route is recorded as a remote garden to a property in North Street.
- 1861 Enclosure Award Broad Chalke Claimed route shown as an open area, not specifically recorded or represented as road.
- 1884 Ordnance Survey 1:2500 map. Shows route as fenced road, gated at north end and open to Chapel Lane at the southern end.
- 1900 Holly Cottage trading as Bailey's Central Stores and bakery beyond.
- 1910 Inland Revenue Finance Act 1910. Claimed route shown as uncoloured and excluded from any hereditaments. Possibly a public highway.
- 1942 Holly Cottage shop and bakery owned by Mr Fred Penny
- 1957 Bakery still in operation
- 1965 Bakery not used for baking and rented to Mr Bill Gatehouse as a store.
- 1970 Freehold of the old bakehouse to Mr Gatehouse with right granted for access along claimed route. NB by this time the claimed route has become the property of Holly Cottage.
- 1972 Four businesses operating from the old bakehouse – Bower Valley Timber, Alltype  
to Fencing, Anchor Joint Sealant and Commercial Supplies. Private access granted

- 1978 Holly Cottage trading as Spar Shop owned by Mr and Mrs Sherring.
- 1979 Freehold of old bakehouse to Mr D Blanchard. Operates Bower Valley Fencing only from premises.
- 1980 Holly Cottage now residential and owned by Mrs P Chamont
- 1991 Freehold of northern section of claimed route passed from Holly Cottage title to Mr D Blanchard
- 2002 Revd Lowe bought Sun Cottage
- 2007 Mrs Chamont sold Holly Cottage and southern section of claimed route to Mr J Heminsley.
- 2005 Planning application (S/2005/1527) refused to develop commercial premises of the old bakehouse to residential.
- 2006 Planning Application (S/06/0909) allowed to develop commercial premises of the old bakehouse to residential
- 2007 Mr D Blanchard sold the old bakehouse to Mr J Kot. Property becomes known as The Old Bakehouse. Gates erected on claimed route.
- 2008 Broad Chalke Parish Council apply for public footpath to be added to definitive map and statement.
