This order is made by Wiltshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the Amesbury Rural District Council Area dated 1952 as modified under the provisions of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery of evidence by the authority which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows: -

(i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic;

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates.

The Wiltshire Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is the 7th day of July 2009
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the Amesbury Rural District Council Area dated 1952 as modified under the provisions of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 shall be modified as described in Parts I and II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Wiltshire Council (Sheet SU 24 SW) (Newton Toney 13) Rights of Way Modification Order No. 5 2009.
