NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wiltshire County Council in exercise of its powers under The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders and to install two zebra crossings in Cocklebury Road, Chippenham. The effect will be as follows:-

- A. The County of Wiltshire (Various Roads, Chippenham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One Way) Order, 1982 will be amended for administrative purposes; and (a) to introduce a one way only direction of travel (south-easterly direction) in Monkton Hill (part); (b) to extend the existing no waiting at any time restriction in Cocklebury Road; (c) to extend the existing waiting limited to two hours with return prohibited within two hours between 8am and 6pm Monday to Saturday in Station Hill;
- B. To prohibit the driving of motor vehicles in Monkton Hill (part);
- C. To revoke and re-enact The County of Wiltshire (St. Mary's Place, Chippenham) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1986 for administrative purposes and in order to introduce a prohibition of through traffic in Monkton Hill (part);
- D. To introduce two zebra crossings in Cocklebury Road; one as shown below and one at a point approximately 20 metres north-east of the centreline of Sadlers Mead. Notices are displayed in the roads affected and details may be seen in the Wiltshire Times on 3 October 2003.

Deposit copies of the Orders and Statement of the County Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Orders (A, B and C) above, together with the plans (A, B, C and D) may be inspected at the offices of the Director of Environmental Services, County Hall, Trowbridge during normal office hours. For the convenience of local residents, a copy of the documents may be seen at North Wiltshire District Council, Monkton Park Offices, Monkton Hill, Chippenham during normal office hours for the duration of the objection period.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made should be sent in writing to reach the undersigned by not later than 27 October 2003 quoting reference JM/TRO/CHIP.
