Improving access to general practice

- Social enterprise companies
- Guaranteed acceptance on GP lists
- Info on GP practices, hours and services
- Incentives to encourage GPs to expand
- Access to GPs at convenient times
- PCTs to augment GP services with:
 - new providers
 - more evening surgeries
 - new improved walk-in centres





Improving access to community services

Emphasis on integration of health and social care

- Direct payments
- Individual budgets
- Improving urgent access to:
 - sexual health services
 - mental health services
 - cancer screening
 - end of life services
 - immunisation





Support for people with long-term needs

- Expert Patients Programme
- Better assessment and care planning
- Assistive technologies demonstration projects under way
- Extension of national tariff to long-term conditions
- New deal for carers
