The main project is a set of changing rooms for the girls/boys and match officials. One and possibly two football teams will play there regularly. The youth club of up to 50 members can also play basketball and socialise on the area. A set of floodlights is included in the planning application to be approved shortly, at a total cost of £13,685. Funding above £5,000 is already promised towards this project.</p>
