Dear Sir,

I am very late in responding - hope it's not too late for me to put forward some views on the proposed car parking fees from the Bed and breakfast / self catering group of the Salisbury Tourism Partnership

Mostly there was a consensus of opinion that your ideas were acceptable with just one or two suggestions -

Sunday and evening charges - we would support a minimum charge - say £1.00
Ames, Mere, Downton introduction of charges - split decision here not surprisingly - rural say No city say Yes

Market Traders - should only be allowed a maximum of 2 vehicles in the square on trading days

Market Square Parking Charges - we suggest -
1/2hour = £3.00 1 hour - £4.20 1 1/2 hour - £5.00 It was felt with the parking metres around city - market square parking should be discouraged

It was also felt that Bed and Breakfast/Guest Houses operating within the city centre should be given extra visitors permits free of charge as this is having a detrimental effect on start up business and making those already operating less competitive
