Market Traders - should only be allowed a maximum of 2 vehicles in the square on trading days

Market Square Parking Charges - we suggest -

1/2hour = £3.00 1 hour - £4.20 11/2 hour - £5.00 It was felt with the parking metres around city - market square parking should be discouraged

It was also felt that Bed and Breakfast/Guest Houses operating within the city centre should be given extra visitors permits free of charge as this is having a detrimental effect on start up business and making those already operating less competitive
