CA53. Community Grant Feedback

Representatives from the Hilmarton Neighbourhood First Responder Scheme attended to give a demonstration of the work of their group and to explain how the funding allocated to them was utilized.

CA54. Area 5 Community Area Funding Distribution 2005/

Consideration was given to Report No. 7, circulated with the agenda, which asked Members to consider 2 applications seeking 2006/2007Community Area Award funding.

Resolved:

To agree funding distribution of the Area 5 Community Area Awards budget based on the agreed criteria for 2006/07.

- 1) Calne Development Project Trust Award £1,060 from the revenue budget, towards running a project which will involve young local people in the design and production of a mural to be installed in Calne town centre;
- 2) Calne Music and Arts Festival Award £1,500 from the revenue budget, towards adding additional elements to the Calne Arts and Music Festival in order to extend the Festival to the wider community.
