41 SCRUTINY OF TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

The Corporate Services Manager reminded the Board that regardless of the decision by Council to continue to pursue the Judicial Review process regarding unitary status, it was still prudent to continue to work with the other 4 councils to ensure that the best possible arrangements were made should the legal challenge fail.

The Board raised concerns that, because Kennet was the only council in Wiltshire not based on an executive model, it would find it more difficult to engage with the scrutiny of transitional arrangements. The Board also questioned whether Kennet had sufficient staff capacity to support additional scrutiny arrangements. Members expressed the view that councillors from all 5 councils should avoid a "them and us" approach between the County Council and the District Councils.
