### **In House Foster Care**

Nights are being delivered at slightly less than budgeted unit cost resulting in an underspend despite activity being higher than budget

## In House Residential

Unit costs decreased on previous month with higher occupancy at Towpath. Costs for Orchard still significant.

### **External Foster Care**

Activity currently projected to be less than budgeted for - this is expected as additional Sedgemoor nights have been built in to the budget Unit costs are also lower than budgeted figure

## **External Residential Care**

Currently projected to deliver 2,916 more nights than budgeted for. The overspend relating to this activity is partially offset by the fact that unit costs are lower than budgeted for. There is **RISK** therefore that if unit costs of residential care rise, and placements cannot be made in house or with IFAs, the budget will quickly start to overspend.

# **Disability**

More nights currently being delivered than budgeted for but at a lower unit cost
