I note that Mr Mehmet Nuri Bektasoglu has asked the Licensing Authority to agree to an extension to the opening hours of the above premises.

I would like to register formal objections to this request on behalf of myself and my wife. We live at Crabbes Close, Hyde Lane which is in close proximity to the above premises. The objections are raised on the following grounds:

- 1 Public Nuisance this is a residential area and given the proximity of the nightclub people already hang around and make a considerable amount of noise and mess and it does not seem reasonable or appopriate to extend this in to the early hours of the morning. Extending the hours will mean people will hang around for even longer.
- 2 Prevention of Crime and Disorder As mentioned before, given the proximity of the nightclub it is in everyone's interests for people to disburse quickly when leaving the club so as to mimimise the danger of disturbance and affray. I am sure the police will also be able to advise on this point.

As I am sure you are already aware Mr Bektasoglu has already applied/appealed for planning permission to extend the opening hours on five occasions and been refused each time. The application to yourselves is for even longer opening hours than the last planning appeal.

Can I please ask that you think of local residents and consider the basis of our objections.
