COUNCIL TAX BASE FOR WILTSHIRE COUNCIL 2009-2010

Executive Summary

The Council's tax base is the number of 'Band D Equivalent' households liable to pay council tax at the standard rate to be set through the budget process. The tax base therefore directly impacts both the rate of tax to be set and the total budget yield from council tax:

- If an outline acceptable level of council tax is indicated, the tax base drives the total budget available;
- If the total budget requirement is indicated, the tax base drives the level of council tax to be set.

The tax base is not the same as the actual number of households in the county. It has to be calculated from the number of households in each council tax band A-H adjusted for various discounts, exemptions and disabled relief. The total for each tax band is then converted to a 'Band D Equivalent' – for example, because band A dwellings are charged 6/9 of the council tax, 9 Band A households provide 6 Band D equivalents.

The Council is required to approve its council tax base annually, in accordance with the Local Government Finance Act 1992 and the Local Authorities (Calculation of Council Tax Base) Regulations 1992, with the calculation to be made between the 1 December and 31 January in the financial year preceding that for which the calculation is made.

Under the Local Government (Structural Changes) (Finance) Regulations 2008, the IE has the power to set the tax base for Wiltshire Council.

Proposals

- a) That the calculation of the council tax base for the year 2009/10 is agreed and the council tax base is approved as 177,085.7 for 2009/10.
- a) That the Chief Financial Officer is given delegated authority to determine on 15 January 2009 the Council's estimated Collection Fund balance as at 31 March 2009, in conjunction with the respective Districts' Chief Financial Officers.

COUNCIL TAX BASE FOR WILTSHIRE COUNCIL 2009-2010

Purpose of Report

1. To set out the method of calculating the council tax base for 2009-10 and approve the council tax base for 2009-2010.

Background

- 2. The Council's tax base is the number of 'Band D Equivalent' households liable to pay council tax at the standard rate to be set through the budget process. The tax base therefore directly impacts both the rate of tax to be set and the total budget yield from council tax.
- 2.1 The council tax base has to be approved by the Council before 31 January 2009, therefore the final decision has to be taken at the Implementation Executive Meeting on 10 December 2008.
- 2.2 The 2009-10 tax base in summary for Wiltshire Council is 177,085.7 Band D equivalent households (2008-09 175,838.66).
- 2.3 Further information on the full council tax base calculation is set out in Appendix 1, which also shows the individual calculations for each parish within the county.
- 2.4 The stages in the calculation of the tax base are:
 - i) Calculate the "relevant amount" for the year for each of the valuation bands listed by each District. This is the estimated full year equivalent number of chargeable dwellings listed in each band, after taking into account households entitled to disabled relief, exemptions, and discounts.
 - ii) Convert the "relevant amount" into the equivalent number of Band D dwellings using the following ratios:

- iii) Total the "relevant amounts" for each band.
- iv) Multiply this total of all relevant amounts by the estimated collection rate for the year to give the council tax base.

The collection rate is the percentage of council tax due for the current and previous years that the Council expects to collect after allowing for bad debts and tax that cannot be collected. Collection rates vary across Districts according to the particular circumstances of each District, and for the short term at least, the differences will remain across areas, with a view that these will be harmonised during transition. (Members are asked to note that the collection rate for this purpose is not the same as the

- 'percentage of council tax collected' reported as a key performance indicator.)
- v) Calculate the individual council tax base for the parts of the county subject to a special item e.g. a parish precept.
- vi) The final calculations have been rounded to one decimal place to agree with the statutory requirement for tax base returns to CLG. For consistency it is intended to use this format in future years.
- 2.5 There are a number of variables and adjustments which have been considered before finally determining the Council Tax Base:
 - Losses on collection (an estimate of non-payment by tax payers);
 - Estimated property completions and deletions in 2009-10 and the remaining part of 2008-09 (particularly difficult to estimate in the current economic environment);
 - Possible variations in the number of discounts payable, property exemptions, or changes to the number of MoD occupied properties (Districts have advised that the MoD has no statutory obligation to pay but makes a discretionary payment each year based on the number of homes occupied by service personnel);
 - Estimated reductions in property bandings as a result of successful appeals against bandings to the District Valuer.
- 2.6 For the purposes of this report, it has been assumed that Wiltshire Council will charge 90% of council tax on property that has been empty for more than six months. This 10% discount is current policy in all Wiltshire's Districts except Salisbury. (Members may wish to note that under national regulations council tax is not charged on substantially empty properties for up to six months from the date the property was last occupied; at that point the property becomes "long term empty" and councils have discretion to set a discount between 0% and 50%.)
- 2.7 In addition to the council tax base calculation, an estimate has to made of the surplus or deficit on the Council Tax Collection Fund. This is the difference between the amount actually collected in previous years and the amount forecast to have been collected. This can arise from movements in the actual number of houses built in a given period, the level of non payment and the number of properties attracting relief and discounts compared to the original estimate when setting the council tax base in earlier years. The estimate of Collection Fund deficit or surplus has to be made, by law, on or before 15 January 2009 and Implementation Executive is asked to agree a delegated power to the Chief Financial Officer to set an estimated surplus or deficit as at 31 March 2009 in January. The Council Tax surplus or deficit will be credited or charged to Wiltshire Council, Wiltshire Police Authority and Wiltshire Fire Authority in proportion to their precepts and will be taken into account in setting 2009-10 Council Tax levels.
- 2.8 The council tax base has two different effects on budget discussions, depending on how the budget envelope is being set:

- If an outline acceptable level of council tax is indicated, the tax base drives the total budget available;
- If the total budget requirement is indicated, the tax base drives the level of council tax to be set.

Main Considerations for the Council / Proposals

- 3. In respect of the Council Tax Base, it is recommended that:
- 3.1 The calculation of the council tax base for the year 2009/10 be approved as 177,085.7 Band D equivalent households, an increase of 1,247.0 (0.7%) on 2008-09.
- 3.2 The Chief Financial Officer is given delegated authority to determine on 15 January 2009 the Council's estimated Collection Fund balance as at 31 March 2009, in conjunction with the respective Districts' Chief Financial Officers.

Environmental Impact of the Proposal

Risk Assessment

- 6. There is a low risk that the Council has overestimated the number of Band D properties in the county. One particular variable in the current economic climate is the number of new-build properties that will be completed and occupied during the year. The estimates used have been set at realistic and prudent levels based on experience to date.
- 7. There is a low risk that the actual collection rate of Council Tax due is lower than the anticipated level. Again, one particular variable in the current economic climate is the number of bankruptcies that mean households will be unable to pay council tax and enforcement action would be ineffective.
- 8. In either of these situations, this could lead to a deficit in the Collection Fund which would result in additional funds having to be added in the following financial year. The risks are managed through regular monitoring by the Revenues and Benefits managers and teams, then either taking appropriate corrective action or informing the Chief Finance Officer of the potential budget risk for 2010-11.
- There is a low 'upside risk' that the Council has underestimated either the number of Band D properties in the county or the successful collection rate. This would improve the budget situation and would be identified through the Revenues and Benefits monitoring noted above.

Financial Implications

10. The council tax base is used to calculate the level of council tax for the financial year 2009-10. Changes in the tax base will directly affect the council's budget, as outlined throughout this report.

Legal Implications

11. The legal implications are outlined in the report.

Options Considered

12. The council tax base is calculated using a formula set out by law, and the only variable is the adjustment in the collection rate. This has been set at an appropriate level for each District for 2009-10, following careful review of District and County experience to date, and giving an overall collection rate of 99.4%.

Conclusion

13. Having taken all of the above into account, the council tax base for 2009/10 be approved and set as 177,085.7 Band D Equivalent properties.
