ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (THE RIDGEWAY, WILTSHIRE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2004

The Council of the County of Wiltshire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (2), 22(1) and 22(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed between 1 October and 30 April each year on the length of either the definitive routes of the public rights of way specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, or along the length of the routes in common use as The Ridgeway National Trail, where these vary from the definitive routes.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed between 1 October and 30 April each year on the length of either the definitive routes of the public rights of way specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, or along the length of the routes in common use, where these vary from the definitive routes.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed on the length of either the definitive routes of the public rights of way specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order, or along the length of the routes in common use, where these vary from the definitive routes if the vehicle is being used:
 - (i) in the service of the Local Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in the services of the Police Authority, Fire Brigade, or Ambulance Service;
 - (ii) in connection with any building operation, or demolition in or adjacent to the public rights of way, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the public rights of way, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the public rights of way, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the public rights of way of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- 4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed on the length of either the definitive routes of the public rights of way specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order, or along the length of the routes in common use, where these vary from the definitive routes if the vehicle is being used in connection with the maintenance of land or for associated agricultural purposes.

- 5. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed on the length of either the definitive routes of the public rights of way specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order, or along the length of the routes in common use, where these vary from the definitive routes for the purpose of accessing the properties fronting those lengths of public rights of way.
- 6. This Order shall come into operation on the cited as The County of Wiltshire (The Ridgeway, Wiltshire) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2004.
