6. **Minutes of Previous Meeting**

Resolved: To confirm and sign the minutes of the Committee meeting held on 8 March 2006.

7. **Wootton Bassett: Proposed Construction and Operation of a Waste Transfer Station, Materials Recovery Facility and a Green Waste Composting Facility at Park Grounds Farm for Crapper & Sons Landfill Ltd (N.05.07023)** At the beginning of the item, Mr J Tuck, a local resident, made a statement objecting to the proposal.

The Chairman responded by thanking the speaker for his statement which would be taken into account during the course of the debate.

On considering a report by the Director of Environmental Services and on hearing the views of Mrs MEM Groom as local member,

Resolved:

- (1) *To grant planning permission, subject to the conditions set out in the Director's report.*
- (2) *To request the applicant to set up a local Liaison Group to monitor the working arrangements of the site.*

8. **Devizes: Proposed Retention of a Double Mobile Classroom with Toilets at Southbroom Infants School, The Green (Application No. K.53365)** On considering a report by the Director of Environmental Services,

Resolved: To grant planning permission, subject to the conditions set out in the Director's report.

9. **Exclusion of the Public**

Resolved: To agree, that in accordance with Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972, to exclude the public from the meeting for the business specified in Minute No. 10 because it is likely that if members of the public were present there would be disclosure to them of exempt information as defined in paragraph 2 of Part I of Schedule 12A to the Act and the public interest in withholding the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information to the public.
