APPEAL FOR FREE TRANSPORT ON GROUNDS OF ROUTE SAFETY FROM ROWDE TO DEVIZES SCHOOL

Purpose of Report

1. Members are asked to make a final decision regarding the safety of the walking route from Bunnies Lane, Rowde to Devizes School.
