- 43. Minutes of Previous Meeting

Resolved: To confirm and sign the minutes of the Committee meeting held on 17 September 2008.

44. **Chairman's Announcement** The Chairman made the following announcement:-

<u>School Transport</u> In the light of some future reports regarding school transport appeals likely to be presented for consideration to the next meeting of this Committee on Wednesday 19 November 2008, arrangements had been made for a training session on school transport to take place immediately before that meeting starting at 9.30am.

45. <u>Devizes: Agricultural Reclamation and Improvement Works including Importation of Inert Waste as an Extension to an Existing Permitted Site at Broadway Farm, Nursteed for AG Edwards & Son (K.58622)</u> On considering a report by the Director of Environmental Services and on hearing from Members who had attended the site inspection on Monday 13 October 2008,

<u>Resolved</u>: To grant planning permission, subject to the conditions and for the reasons set out in the Director's report but with Condition No. 13 being amended to read as follows:-

13. No operations shall take place on the site except between the hours of:

07.00 – 18.00 Monday to Friday 07.00 – 13.00 Saturday

In addition no vehicles importing inert waste material shall enter or leave the site between the following hours:

08.15 - 09.15 and 14.45 - 15.45 Monday to Friday during Nursteed Community Primary School term time.

No operations shall be carried out at any time on Sunday, Bank and Public Holidays.

Reason: In the interests of highway safety, residential amenity

and the amenity of school children at drop off and

pick up times.

46. Wylye: Proposed Addition of Footpath No 11, Wylye to Definitive Map and Statement

Resolved: To note that the proposal had been deferred until the next meeting of the Committee due to be held on 19 November 2008, following a request from the landowner's newly engaged solicitors for further time in order to familiarise themselves with the circumstances of the case.
