- Ombudsman's Annual Letter
- Staff Code of Conduct

- Wider role of Committee to reconsider Committee's terms of reference
- Annual Audit and Inspection Letter (if it contains any ethical governance issues)

As can be seen from the above list, the Committee has already identified quite a heavy workload for itself with a number of areas that the Committee should indeed be examining. However, as this is a transitional year prior to the Council becoming a unitary council in April 2009, the Committee may consider it necessary from a practical and realistic point of view, to prioritise its workload and focus its efforts on key areas.

The main area of activity for the Committee would appear to be to continue to work with the district councils over harmonisation of documentation and procedures to ensure a consistent approach within Wiltshire, the shaping of the Committee under the new authority and overseeing the preparations for a new Constitution.
