- National reporting systems (Waste Data Flow, Flycapture) contacted to prepare for change to one council

- Transition project PID updated to include 2009/10 savings target.
- Transition work areas clarified including distinction between Transition and Transformation workstreams.
- Draft 'must dos' for Transition project produced.
- Transition project work transferred to Microsoft Project.
- Agreed to ensure focus on Transition and 1st April 2009 'must dos'.





Transformation Group

- PID updated to include efficiency savings.
- Transformation project work areas identified and split from Transition project.
- Project plan timeline updated.
- Work commenced on developing options for future service delivery.





Promotional Service for Waste

- Scope of activity is being developed and refined.
- Investigation of selected exemplar local authorities largely complete (survey of top ten recycling unitary authorities to be added.
- Investigation of public views is largely complete.
- Delivery model options have been defined.
- Detailed appraisal of options has been completed.
- Investigation of legal agreement (if required) has commenced.





Enforcement & Regulation

- Scoping of waste areas has been completed.
- Areas where harmonisation of policies and working practices is required have been identified.
- Work is progressing on areas of harmonisation.
- Enforcement policy has been drafted and circulated to project team for consultation.
- Work is ongoing to identify and investigate possible quick wins
- PID is being amended to include street scene enforcement and regulation project
