The project is being run by Calne Cricket Club, which has very strong links with the local community. The first two months of funding for this project have been found. This application represents the clubs aspiration to provide continuity for young people involved by enabling them to continue to receive coaching indoors until the end of March, when, hopefully, better weather enables the group to move outside. We are a very active group who try to link ourselves with the issues raised in the community plan. We actively try to help children and young adults to channel energy into being constructive rather than destructive. We actively work with the local comprehensive school and at least 5 other primary schools. In 2007 we are working with the ECB 'Chance to Shine' project to take cricket into schools to attract more children to our after school activities. We all work voluntarily and gain a lot of self-satisfaction.


