What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? Full size goals are essential in drawing more players from the ages of 11 through 16 into football as the players progress from mini-soccer (and small-sided goals) to full pitch, full size, 11 a-side football from the age of 11.

Last year Derry Hill United fully funded a pair of portable, full-sized, football goals to help facilitate the expansion and the development of the full-sized game within the Club. Whilst this initiative in itself has been a success, the portable goals have been difficult to position, and are only able to be used when a number of adult helpers are present to assist in lifting them to the training area where they are required. The 'Move Our Goals' project seeks to address this issue, by providing funding to purchase a set of flip-up wheels for each goal.

If successful, the provision of a set of wheels will allow easy movement of the goals to any area of our training facility by just one adult. Such initiatives are essential for the Club to continue its expansion, provided continued and additional access to quality training and football activities to youths within the community from the ages 11 through 16.

3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

DHUFC currently supports 185 boys and girls from Calne and the surrounding villages to actively participate in team sports. Further, to date we have encouraged and funded over 35 adults to take coaching qualifications in support of our players.

Derry Hill United has been awarded the FA's Charter Standard which sets standards of coaching, administration and child protection for clubs working with young people. Each squad is supported by adult coaches who have trained and qualified in football coaching, Emergency Aid and Child Protection Awareness as well as having been checked by the FAs CRB unit. The Club has code of conduct, equal opportunity policy and public liability insurance.

Derry Hill United is the largest and most active Club within this community and has plans to maintain and enhance this position through the development of a Youth Volunteer Program to support and encourage young people to help give back to their community through football. The seeds of the programme are already in place with the Club signing up to offer youths access to 'Step Into Sport' places. The Club has recently funded seven 14 year olds through their Class 8 Referees qualification and intends to offer funded access to coaching courses as our members reach the age of 16.
