What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?					
This project will benefit the community in many ways. Calne has a diverse demographic with a large number of					
families on benefits and in low cost housing. Many of these parents find themselves socially isolated as they are					
unable to use the current facilities in Calne mainly due to costs. Calne is a growing community with families					
moving into Calne on the new estates being built with more disposible income. We aim to meet the needs of all					
of these parents by providing a low cost environment where parents can bring their children and they can play					
safely while the parents relax and socialise.					

The cafe is aimed at parents with pre-school aged children. There is no where else in Calne for parents to go with their children which is priced resonably that also provides a space for children to play.

In our pilot scheme, which is currently running, we have had a growing number of mums coming each week, starting with 15 mums and now running at regularly double that proving that this is a space that is much needed. We want the cafe to be a well run and lovely place for mums to come. Somewhere that is meeting the needs of mums rather than just the childrens. We want to create an environment where the mums are served and can have someone cater for their needs for a few hours on a Friday morning. We want to provide real value for money, serving good food in a great environment, for example we are not charging for drinks for the children, and we are charging 50p per item for everything else, to keep it simple and cheap, we do not charge people to come in and there is no obligation to buy anything. We hope that the project will continue to grow and we can expand the cafe to extra hours and days.

3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

We have been running a pilot scheme which has been invaluable in narrowing down and discovering what we need to make it a successful project. We have consulted with hundreds of mums in the area before starting this project to find out if it was needed or wanted. In our research we found that there are 5 other cafes in Calne only one of these provides high chairs and a small play area. The costs ranged from £1.20 to £3.00 for a coffee and slice of cake. There is a soft play centre in Calne but this costs from £2.10 upwards for a mum with just one child to get into, the costs of drinks and food are extra. Our pilot scheme has seen our numbers increase every week. We regularly serve 30 mums on a Friday morning. We will be monitoring the project closely to see what the demographic of mums we are catering for is, what numbers we are getting and we will be asking the mums what we can do to improve the café, all of this will help to create a well run self sustaining, community project.
