The project will provide a great opportunity for young people to get involved in a dynamic and vibrant, up and coming sport that has generated a great level of interest in the last 12 months throughout the country. The activity channels young peoples' energy into constructive activity and provides an excellent opportunity for them to stay fit and involved in healthy physical activity.

There is a tremendous deal of respect within the Parkour community and the young people of calne have met and trained with some of the best exponents of the sport in the country. Consequently this will encourage peer support and promotes safety and well being of participants.

This project will enable the group to invite the best practitioners of Parkour over to Calne and assist them with the development of their group. This in turn will increase the interest in the sport and attract new members to the group providing young people with a focus.

Participants involved in the project will benefit from increased self esteem, increased activity levels, knowledge and understanding of health benefits, opportunities to develop leadership skills and the experience of being involved with setting up and advertising a new activity group.

Directly the project will aim to benefit 20 - 40 young people, and potentially more as the group expands and develops. Indirectly the residents of Calne will benefit with young people being involved in a focused, regular activity that offers a diversion from less appropriate activities.
