<b>What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?</b> Storenet / Nitenet enables real-time communication of information between individuals and organisations to combat potential issues that may arise. MRS Communications successfully operate Storenet / Nitenet in 160 cities and towns in the UK, (including market towns such as Devizes & Trowbridge to name two locally). Calne Town Council is launching and promoting the use of Storenet / Nitenet to businesses in the town in February 2008 to strengthen community partnership working by improving communication between businesses, CCTV and the police in order to reduce potential anti-social behaviour, crime and the fear of crime. All business organisations within the town will have the opportunity to benefit from the scheme. Outcome will be Improved partnership real-time communication reducing potential anti-social behaviour, crime and the fear of crime.

Calne Town Council plans to purchase 10 radios and associated equipment at the cost of £3950 plus V.A.T. to initiate this project. These radios will be programmed for use by the outdoor Groundstaff, Information Centre, CCTV Room and Police Station. Additional radios are sought for the PCSO's (NPT), parking attendents and also to be used as a pilot to encourage businesses into the scheme. Safer & Stronger Communities Fund will be supporting the scheme by contributing the money for 2 radios. This application is being made to enable a further two to be available for the benefit of the business community to pilot the scheme before signing up to their own rental agreements. The Base station will be housed at Bank House early February 2008.  
Initial radios to be programmed to individual call signs and then distributed - to be followed by staff training. Presentation already given to Pubwatch meeting 7/1/08.  
Business Survey to be undertaken February – which will include information on the launch – to encourage businesses to enter scheme. Press / Media publicity on launch date – TBA.
