Since then Calne became twinned with Caln Township, Pennsylvania, USA in 1982 and Eningen-unter-Achalm, Germany in 1988. Charlieu and Eningen are also twinned with one another. The aim of the association, as stated in its constitution, is to foster friendship between the neighbourhoods of Calne and its 3 twinned towns. Up to and including 2007, a bi-national meeting model was followed for the European twins, where each town visited one of the others every two years. So, for example, Calne visited Charlieu in 2006 and hosted Charlieu in 2007, whilst Eningen visited Calne in 2006 and hosted Calne in 2007. For 2008 and onwards a tri-national meeting model has been adopted, where each town hosts the other 2 towns every 3 years - Eningen acting as the host in 2008, Charlieu in 2009 and Calne in 2010. To help raise funds for 2010, but also to maintain interest amongst the members and encourage new members to join, the association has started to develop a more active schedule of social events. It is for these social events, which will take place about once a month, that a projector and screen is needed to promote twinning. The equipment would be used to give presentations on aspects of twinning, to give a picture show of past twinning visits and to act as an aid in general (e.g., for quiz nights). The number of people at each event will vary, but normally from 30 to 50.

## 3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

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Unlike the other European twins, where there is a guaranteed income stream from local government, the association has a funding problem. The attached accounts for the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> October 2007, which have been independently examined, show that the association's finances are in decline, with the closing balance falling from £2,575.43 to £1,397.33. The decision to adopt a tri-national meeting model was in part taken in order to give Calne enough time to build up its funds to host a visit in 2010. The association has made a separate application to the Town Council for a funding stream over the next 3 years to help meet the estimated costs of this visit. By the time of writing the Town Council had agreed to provide funding on this basis, showing its commitment to the association both now and in the immediate future, but the exact amount has still to be agreed. Note that this grant will not cover the cost of the proposed equipment. The association wishes to raise its profile within the community, particularly in the local schools, and increase its membership. The proposed equipment, by for example giving a slide show of past visits, should help the association to meet this aim. The group within the community most likely to show interest are couples whose children have left the home and hence have more time and opportunity to get involved.
