Castlefields Park and River Park Association (CARP) is an established charity with a positive track record of delivering improvements to Castlefields Park through working with NWDC, Calne Town Council, local groups and organisations. Through a combination of fund raising to gain grants for construction projects and by volunteers physically working on projects, improvements have included the building of a pocket park, trim trail, new paths and seating, wild flower meadow, art works, new park gates, new drainage, annual river rubbish clearances as well as holding community events such as the annual Easter Egg Hunt. CARP includes representatives from local interest groups including conservation volunteers, Calne Artists Group, Wilts and Berks Canal Trust, Calne Town and NWDC Councillors, and has a network of supporting experts in landscape design, engineering and river restoration. The CARP Working Group meets at least monthly on site to maintain existing projects or to deliver new improvements. The proposed Cheveywell Gardens would be delivered by a combination of contractors to do the very heavy work in digging out the old soil, with the working group undertaking the rest of the work including the fixing of the trellis and mosaic, and undertaking the planting and maintenance. Thus it will be very much a community project.
