What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? Middle Common, Kington Langley is a Registered Common in the Conservation Area of Kington Langley. The road edges of the common has been suffering from major erosion in recent years due to vehicles driving over the edges of the grass when delivering and collecting children from Langley Fitzurse School and by vehicles driving past cars parked to collect children and consequently riding over the edges. The edges are now significantly eroded, rutted and muddy and are already a potential hazard for walkers and cyclists. The benefit of the project is: To provide a firm 'Grasscreted' area with curb edging on the edge of the Registered Common alongside the school where parents can set down and pick up their children To provide a safe edge free from ruts and water-logging To re-instate damaged parts of the Common which is central to the outstanding visual appearance of the middle of the village The whole village (600+ villagers) plus through traffic will benefit.
