Currently the entrance to the Chapel is very muddy with no hard standing for people and especially disabled people to get from their car to the Chapel. The highway outside the Chapel is single track which causes further problems with traffic congestion.							
The proposal will allow cars to pull onto the hard standing to allow people to unload as well as pedestrians walking into the Chapel with clean feet.							
We have 180 adults on the electoral register plus their families and visitors to this Parish. This improvement could benefit approximately 300 people.

Each year North Wraxall Parish Council looks to improve the local area for the benefit of all the parishioners, examples of previous improvements include repairs to two bus shelters and the rebuilding of Upper Wraxall bus shelter, fencing around the village green in Upper Wraxall, replacement seating around the pond in Upper Wraxall.

This year's project is to improve the frontage to the Chapel in North Wraxall, the verge is owned by the Council and is currently very unstable and muddy, we hope to improve the access to the Chapel for all the local residence and also visitors to this Parish.

By introducing a footpath and raising the level of the road next to the existing kerb stones we shall not only improve the access to people walking to the Chapel but will also allow temporary parking for vehicles to allow people to unload, especially the old and disabled.
