What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?
Approximately one quarter of the playing field, specifically the area of the football pitch, currently suffers from water-logging which prevents use and by the football club and other field users. When this happens games have to be cancelled during Autumn and Winter or even at other times after heavy rain with the consequence that income is not forthcoming from the regular users.

The Playing Fields Association is self-funded and finances the recreational facilities for villagers and other local users, including maintaining the greens, a tennis court and providing play area. Without a regular source of funds these facilities cannot be provided.

The project is to dig out and install land drains across the affected area (a total of approximately 172 linear metres).

All users of the playing field, including cricket club, football club, and village users in general will benefit from the site being drained.

The village is seeking to encourage active participation in village sports by the local teenagers. This provides more opportunities for expression and also healthy exercise. Unless this can be provided on a consistent and predictable basis, the teenagers do not see this as a worthwhile activity.

The Playing Fields Association also has limited funds and those which it does have this year will also need to be used at the villagers' request to provide better changing room facilities for sports users plus a more suitable pavilion.
