What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? The 1st Chippenham Scout Group comprises around 60 boys and girls from the Chippenham area aged from 6 (Beavers) to 14 (Scouts). Over the last year, the Group has grown and now has a strong and enthusiastic management committee, keen to ensure that the best possible facilities and scouting experience is provided to the children in the Group. The Hall is used throughout the week by the Scout Group and to a limited extent by local Community groups. However, the state of repair of the Hall floor means that we cannot make the Hall more widely available to those Community groups who have expressed interest in using it. The Hall has been in use for many years and over these years, the wooden floor, which I believe is the original one put in when the Hall was built in the 1930's, has received heavy use and is now in serious need of repair. The Group has recently raised over £3,000 to replace the roof of the Scout Hall, funding this through fund raising activities (sponsored cycle, raffle, table top sale etc.) and from donations. Now the Hall is watertight, we want to refurbish the interior such that we can provide a better environment in which our young people can meet and which can be used by other local Community groups. NWDC will not meet future running costs for projects. Please tell us how these will be met in the future
