Volunteers from the community will include local interest groups, school children, students and young people. The volunteers will have the opportunity to work in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Community spirit will be fostered as people work together to find out more about their shared, local heritage. Archaeology is a multi-skilled discipline involving literacy, numeracy and communication skills, a great opportunity for informal learning. After the excavation a report will be written and copies sent to the County Archaeologist, and all the volunteers involved. We are looking for funding to let more people locally find out the results of the excavation. We would do this through photographs, web-pages, blogs and podcasts on the Wessex Archaeology website. We would visit local schools and produce a leaflet for them and for local distribution. An article would be offered to the parish magazine and links made from the project web-pages to the parish website. Public lectures would be given locally. This is a unique opportunity for local children to have access to a site like this on their doorstep. We will be inviting local schools to visit the site, but we are also aware of difficulties this may cause with transport etc, so we are also planning on visiting the local schools to ensure maximum benefit. NWDC will not meet future running costs for projects. Please tell us how these will be met in the future It will not be essential to continue the project into next year, though it would be highly desirable. Further funding will be sought from elsewhere.

*Last year 50 volunteers from local interest groups took part in a three week excavation funded by English Heritage. Interest and enthusiasm was demonstrated both by the number of people who volunteered to help and the excellent feedback we received. Much local interest was generated and walkers along the footpath adjacent to the site became regular visitors. A site visit was arranged for students from Swindon and was clearly of benefit to them.

*This year we want to extend these benefits more widely. We want to invite people to the site who have not had experience of archaeology before, for example school children. We also want to let more people know about what is discovered in their area – their own heritage.

*The national curriculum for both KS1 and KS2 involves local history and using a range of information to find out about historical enquiries. KS1 specifically mentions "the way of life of people in the more distant past" and KS2 mentions "how an aspect in the local area has changed over a long period of time" as well as "the Romans"

*The site is on private land, not usually open to the public and the project has been made possible by the help and enthusiasm of the landowner, Mr Antony Little and the willing co-operation of his neighbours. He supports our aim to let more people benefit from this exciting project.
