With National Government recognising the benefits of a healthy lifestyle, it is essential that local sports bodies do all they can to encourage children away from their armchairs and into pursuits which, it is hoped, will stay with them throughout their lives. Corsham ASC has its part to play in this process, by liaising with local schools and assisting them with meeting their curricula targets eg the requirement that each child should be able to swim 25 metres by the age of 11. An inter schools gala will attract upwards of 100 local children (possibly more), many of whom would not normally get this opportunity. It also allows the Club to assess children with potential and determine their suitability for advanced programmes of excellence training. In terms of teacher training, this is essential to make up the current shortfall of qualified instructors across the North Wilts area. Corsham ASC provides a "teach to swim" programme for 80 local children (including complete beginners) and maintains a waiting list for those wishing to join. The Club also runs a Masters section, which provides swimming for 40 adult swimmers. Training new teachers is essential if we are to continue to provide resources for local children to swim in their local pool. Teacher/coach development is also essential, in order to maintain and improve the skills of the existing team. The skills clinic will not only benefit the Clubs 100+ squad swimmers, but also provide a forum for discussion by the coaching team. The limited amount of poolside equipment required will be used to support the schools gala and supplement the Clubs existing resources NWDC will not meet future running costs for projects. Please tell us how these will be met in future. The Club does have some limited support from the Wiltshire and Swindon Sports Partnership (WASSP) and the County ASA. We would look to them to assist with future projects of the nature described above, but would also seek funding from local businesses and sponsors. Since forming in 1973, Corsham ASC has taught literally hundreds of youngsters from the local community to swim, some of whom have gone on to National standard. Very much a "Club for all", Corsham ASC was the first in Wiltshire to gain the ASA's coveted Swim 21 accreditation, a nationally judged award which is only issued to those who demonstrate excellence in child protection, health and safety, teaching proficiency and administration. At the current time, less than 10% of the Country's swimming clubs has this status. All of the coaching and teaching staff are volunteers, and the Club receives no funding from any other source. The Club does maintain links with the seven local primary schools and has members at all of them. A schools gala will undoubtedly attract much local interest and act as a catalyst for local children to want to take up swimming on a regular basis. It will also assist the schools to assess where they are with their curricula targets. The Club's involvement with the local community is well documented. We provide many of the officials and helpers for the annual Springfield triathlon, and run our own Open gala, which attracts in excess of 200 local swimmers. We also have links with the local Service community at Basil Hill and Rudloe. If awarded, the Community Grant would be the first substantial sum of money the Club has ever received. It is appropriate, therefore, that it should be spent on something which will benefit the youngsters of Corsham and, hopefully, enthuse them to join in with what is possibly the best all round aerobic exercise programme available.
