 What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? The whole village will benefit from a series of activities and events over the next 6 months to raise awareness and work with NWDC and WCC to promote the uptake of practical ways in which Colerne residents can minimise waste and increase recycling. Several activities will be focussed specifically on engaging school children and young people as we believe that this is a particularly effective way of getting messages to households and village residents. To lead the campaign we have created a character called 'eco-ernie' (based on a green cube-man similar to Mr Strong in the Mister Men). An adult-sized costume will be made up and eco-ernie will become a regular feature at our recycling campaign activities and events, which will include: 'eco-ernie' childrens recycling competitions with attractive, environmentally friendly prizes targeted at Colerne School, Scouts, Guides, Cubs and Brownies 'eco-ernie' colour fridge magnets with key recycling messages 'wash and squash' plastic bottles and 'pack it flat' for cardboard. These will be delivered with the Parish Magazine to every household in Colerne Colour posters in the village shops and colour noticeboard at the new trial plastic bottle and cardboard recycling station at the recreation ground. The posters and notreboard will promote our target to increase recycling so that we become on the top recycling villages in North Wiltshire (see below). Flyers and regular articles in Colerne Parish Magazine to highlight recycling data and provide practical tips and hints for waste minimisation and recycling Inviting expert speakers from local and national organisations to provide a programme of talks at the Fox and Hounds pub on the first Tuesday evening of each month Recycling festival in September in the Rugby Club and surrounding grounds. The awareness campaign will support the 6-month trial of plastic bottle and cardboard recycling in Colerne which NWDC will launch in May. The success of this trial is dependant on raising awareness in the village that only plastic bottles can be recycled, and that these must be washed and squashed to conserve space and reduce contamination. The cardboard must be flattened and any plastic inserts must be removed. Ecolerne will work closely with NWDC, WCC and Hills recycling to ensure that these important messages are promoted effectively. Data provided by NWDC shows that Colerne currently recycles 10.6 kg per household per month compared to the top 25% of villages in North Wiltshire recycle which more than 12.5 kg per household per month. We want Colerne to catch up with the top performers. We will report monthly recycling data in the Parish Magazine, local shops and through a dedicated noticeboard to spotlight the increases in recycling rates achieved by the village, and any issues that need to be addressed. Ecolerne will regularly inspect the plastic and cardboard recycling facilities to check that they are being used correctly. Our campaign will have a particular focus on engaging children and yound people, we will apply for the majority of the matched funding from the Local Network Fund for Children and Young People. This fund assists small locally managed community groups to carry out activities with a direct benefit to children and young people.
