What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? As a result of its recent, innovative work in four local Primary Schools, Corsham CC has an ever increasing number of young people in junior membership of the club which now stands at 105. In addition the club runs four senior teams on a Saturday and two on a Sunday from a senior membership of 58 players. The First X1 plays in the West of England Premier Division One and provides a high level of cricket excellence within the Town. The Club hosts a three day Minor County game each season which is well supported by local people and enhances the clubs and the Towns reputation. It is suggested that no other club in Area 4 reaches this standard of sporting excellence. The club is recognised by the England and Wales Cricket Board as a Focus Club. It has Clubmark Accreditation and eleven ECB qualified coaches. There are plans to increase the number of coaches to cater for the influx of children through attendance at ECB coach education courses. The club is the only one in Wiltshire, at the present time, to have two Level 3 coaches. The club allows the use of the nets to all members at any time and during school holidays. After school the practice nets are inundated with young people. As a consequence, over a ten year period, since the existing nets were installed, the surfaces have become badly worn and dangerous and the netting has to be repaired at the end of each season. Whilst the club has a well appointed pavilion, and an excellent playing surface, the practice facilities are worn out and unbefitting a club of Corsham Status. The club serves a wide catchment area of villages and 45 of the existing 105 junior members live outside the Corsham Town area (Appendix 1)In season 2008 the club plans to extend its current activities of holiday coaching camps and school extra curricular coaching to provide an 'after school club' at the ground thereby enabling a another pathway for young people to join the club. Strategic Framework

Corsham CCs proposal meets an objective of the Sport England Regional Strategy for Sport 2004-2008. which states that 'organisations must demonstrate how their facilities meet the need to drive up participation in sport' P 15

The ECBs National Strategy for Cricket states that' every affiliated club should have access to practice facilities' and that there should be an 'increase in the number of children playing in junior sections by 50,000'

It is suggested that the Corsham proposals are consistent with national, regional and local policy.

Local Partnership building

With regard to links with the District Council, the club has had detailed discussions with the Councils Sports Development Officer with a view to introducing new initiates in season 2008 which will include a Corsham Schools festival and an 'after school club' at the ground. In addition the club has entered into an agreement with the Cricket Foundation to undertake 280 hours of coaching in 4 Primary Schools and two Secondary Schools from March to July 2008

(Letters of support are appended to the application from the District Sports Development Officer and the ECBs Cricket Development Manager for Wiltshire.)

All of these activities coupled with the existing programme will increase participation and put greater demands on the clubs facilities.
