<p>What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? The exercise project will encourage older people to take part in physical activity by training Extend tutors who will offer exercise sessions to groups of people. This will help them to retain mobility, improve balance and prevent falls thereby enabling longer healthy independent living. We offer a range of services of other services to older people. Information and advice staff provide help with issues that affect older people such as welfare benefits, community care, housing, health and legal issues. Our befriending service helps people remain independent and socially included. Our nail cutting service promotes health and mobility. Our home support and gardening services help people remain in their homes and improve personal and community safety. We campaign on issues affecting older people and undertake research into their needs. We raise awareness of safety, healthy living and offer public information through our newsletters, talks and media work. We need to ensure that as many older people as possible are aware of these services through regular and on going promotion through leaflets and talks. In 2006-7 our befriending and information and advice services directly supported 63 people in Corsham and our Community Services team provided support to Colerne Lunch Club who offer companionship and a meal to 25 older people. We offer nail care clinics at Jargeau Court and Spring Tinings and have strated in 2007 to provide garden maintenace to clients in Corsham and the surrounding areas. We would expect that the number of people who benefit from our services will increase with additional promotion about what help is available from Age Concern Wiltshire.</p>

Beyond the Immediate report into the needs of Over 50s in Wiltshire found that 36% of the population of Wiltshire is estimated to be over 50 and this is projected to increase in the coming years. The report identifies a number of key challenges and opportunities which can be addressed by increasing public knowledge of the services available, including access to physical activity, health and social care services, personal and community safety and increased financial and social inclusion.
