This will provide better quality training and practice facilities for the youth section of Box Cricket Club. It is likely to benefit approximately 30 children ranging from the ages of 9 to 16 who are involved in cricket at the club, and they will have better opportunities to improve through the use of this facility. The cage fits around a cricket pitch and enables young players to bowl and bat in a safe environment without the need to fetch any balls that are hit far away. This helps to focus their concentration and prevents frustration and boredom creeping in from having to go and fetch balls. It will also act to encourage more young players down to the club when they see better training facilities being provided.
