This is often simultaneous as both assocs have meetings most evenings. There are no other facilities available in the building. Using a food preparation area for the preparation and cleaning up of craft activities is a hygiene concern. It is also logiistically very difficult and dangerous. Both groups of children are encouraged to think for and look after themselves. However, when one group is cooking and the other is cleaning up after an activity there can be upto 20 children in a small space with a lit stove. It is hoped to convert what is currently a chair store into a utility/wash area. This can be done relatively easily by running a water supply from the toilets, installing a vent, sinks and work surfaces. The purpose of both movements is to foster community spirit in young people through widening their experiences and getting them involved. By this it is hoped that the young people will become more self reliant & better citizens. The Guide movement in Corsham has approx 80 members and the Scouts about 150 members. The hall is also used by other community groups from the area as well as guides and scouts from the surrounding parishes such as Neston and Colerne. The Guides and Brownies from throughout the District would like to hold sleepovers here, in line with their activities programme, but the lack of washing facilities prevent this.
