What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit? (IMPORTANT: PLEASE DO NOT TYPE IN PARAGRAPHS – THIS SECTION IS LIMITED TO 1500 CHARACTERS ONLY (INCLUSIVE OF SPACES)) The Green Room is a very busy club with 80 members, 18 adult helpers who work in rota & strives to keep all the local young people engaged with sporting, arts and craft, dance & organising activities. Our own youth council are good at communicating and helping achieve their wish list. Soon we will have larger premises & will be in a position to engage far more young people with more space available. We have 30 -40 young people each club night. Most of our members want sporting and dance activities and we have for the last 18 months hired Sportzcoach from Corsham to run activity sessions inc football, hockey, rounders, cricket etc. We have also carried out a number of dance sessions which are particularly popular with the girls and which are in high demand. The girls are now planning a dance show. All of these are expensive and to-date we have managed to find funds but are keen to commit to the next year's worth of sporting activities, whilst searching for funding for April 09-2010. The GR has demonstrated to the community that young people can not only gather safely, but also demonstrate their capability to organise and mix well despite quite large age differences (11-18). The Parish Council has reported a drop in Anti-social behaviour locally - & with more funding we can engage young people on more evenings and reduce ASB even further. We anticipate doubling our membership over the next year, with our new space and have an even higher need for sports/dance coaches .

3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

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Consultation with the youth club members is on-going through the council. The top requests are the sports/dance mentioned. The girls believe that running more dance classes (run on a different night) will encourage more girls to join. We do run fundraising events with the members, but these can only produce a limited amount of additional revenue (for eg bad weather meant we had three low fundraisers last year). We would like to try & get our funding for this year in place in order to start fundraising for next year and put ourselves in a more stable position. Most of the money we already have is allocated to other bills - eg insurance, affiliation, licences, running costs, winter rent etc. An increase in membership will mean we require additional resources for all new members, to meet the high demand for sports/dance. We usually involve others in the community to help when possible, as well as the helpers already involved. Our approach to providing activities for young people addresses the every child matters agenda in terms of keeping young people active, safe, enjoying and achieving & making a positive contribution. We operate the club 50 weeks pa (shut only at Christmas) as the demand has shown that young people need the club open throughout the year - as there is little else to engage young people locally. There is an assumption that everyone is on 'holiday' out of term time, but our club nights have shown this is not the case for many of our members.


