Set in 20 acres of grounds, with all weather training, a superb Clubhouse with 10 changing rooms and refreshment area, AFC Corsham enjoys some of the best football facilities in the South West.						
Leafy Lane Playing Fields allows free use of the all weather training facility to all members of AFC Corsham football club (more than 150 members aged between 6 - 16 years of age). In addition, groups from the surrounding area use the facility throughout the year resulting in approximately 300 people utilising the all weather pitch each week.						
During the winter months (when the facility is needed most) the absence of a path from the changing rooms to the all weather pitch results in a significant amount of mud being generated. The area immediately outside of the facility can become very muddy and mud can be transported onto the all weather playing surface.						
The benefit to the community of the proposed project is to improve the facilities for young people to meet for recreation and to prevent damage to the training facility such that it is maintained in excellent condition. Access to the facility will be greatly improved with regards to accessibility for disabled and mothers with prams; allowing them to view and collect their children safetly.
