As well as entertainment, educational and social engagement, the community will benefit directly through Write Turn's performances and indirectly via a richer artistic diversity.

Dr Mike Johnson teaches Creative Writing for The Open University and is a well-published poet, specialising in children's poetry;

Nicola McNee is a school librarian and published poet, with over 25 years public service, including participation in Arts activities;

Linda Snell is a published and prize-winning poet, and the former sub-editor of a professional science journal, published in London. (These three writers will initially be the performing group 'Write Turn', formed to promote poetry in north west Wiltshire.) Our approach is inclusive: any- and everyone may participate in and enjoy the proposed activities, contributing to lifelong learning in the community.
