<p>The second top answer to the question in the community plan re 'main thing you like or value', is a sense of community and close behind is valuing history/architecture. In addition the local community's 2nd top priority is the provision of high quality local schools and with that provision a strong sense of community surrounding that is essential.</p> <p>The Rudloe Community is disjointed and isolated. It's geographic location has no identifiable centre and links to the MOD make its composition transient. Common issues revolve around identity and social isolation. The primary school forms one of few identifiable common places. Rudloe has a rich history linked to the stone quarries, the creation of Box Tunnel and to the MOD and this project reflects the commitment of the PTA towards encouraging a more joined-up community that is proud of it's heritage. FOBS wants to encourage older members of the community to share stories and experiences with younger people and to create a piece of artwork together that will symbolise community and education extending beyond generations.</p> <p>Number benefiting - Rudloe has 1368 on the electoral register this project is aimed at all of these people plus members of the school community living on the Katherine Park estate.</p>

The school at Rudloe has undergone great change in the past 12 months from uncertainty under special measures to a vibrant, happy place. Locally, areas of Rudloe have been identified as suffering from deprivation and, as the catchment area of the school is made up of a collection of separate housing estates, it also has trouble identifying social commonalities. However, the school has consistently provided a common interest for all families living in the area. The potential threat to its existence, last year, provided an impetus for community action, evident in higher numbers of people from beyond the immediate school community turning out to support fundraising events held by 'FOBs' and meetings about it's future. This support seems to continue now that the school has been removed from special measures and it's future, as part of Corsham Primary School has been secured.

To celebrate the school and to try to further engage with people in the community who are not directly linked with it, the PTA is running an intergenerational community arts project. The PTA is running a competition encouraging people from across the local community to produce a piece of artwork/writing that illustrates something good about living or going to school in Rudloe. In the autumn this work will be used as the inspiration for an artist when he comes to work with local people to create a sculpture that will stand outside the school gates to symbolise education and community.
