Colerne is a village with just over one thousand houses and the combined groups have a current membership of approximately 120. In addition to the 120 who benefit directly the whole community benefits as the Groups provide young people with activities within the village. Thus assisting with the aims of the Community Plan relating to the provision of facilities for young prople, particularly in the villages and assisting with the broader education of young people. personal letters being sent to a significant number of people in the village and by means of publicity in the							
monthly Parish Magazine. To date a total of almost £10,000 has been raised. As the work on the main project							
had to be started so that the hut is available for use again at the start of the autumn term no grant has been							
requested for that work which is currently forecast to cost in excess of £25,000. The installation of new doors							
will improve the energy efficiency of the building.
