3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

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The mini-beast project was conceived after a visit to the school by Hilary Leng who is the schools' liaison officer of Wiltshire Wildlife Trust. Attention has been paid to practical issues such as fabrication of raised beds and installation of a greenhouse so that PTA and other volunteers can be involved without the need (and expense) of professional contractors (with the exception of some specialist tree surgery and joinery – see quotes herewith). Compost from re-cycled garden waste will be supplied by Hills Waste Solutions Ltd and paths will be created using tree bark. The new facilities will be used as a "springboard" for other learning initiatives particularly associated with plants. For example wild flower seeds can be grown in plugs and planted out around the periphery of the school playing fields for the benefit of children and residents alike. Vegetable seedlings raised in the greenhouse can be used in a plot on the margin of the recreation ground to enhance the scope for learning about food and where it comes from. An awareness of the delicate balance in which nature hangs is an important grain to sow in any young mind.
